



VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT



The Divisional Director Health Services, Quetta Division invites applications from eligible and qualified Female candidates from all over Pakistan for the appointment to **(60)** vacant positions of **Female Staff Nurses (BPS-16)** at the Sandeman Provincial Hospital Quetta, on purely Adhoc/Contract basis for a period of 2 years, extendable based on satisfactory performance.

Interviews will be conducted on **30th and 31st December 2024**, between 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM at the office of the Divisional Director Health Services, Quetta Division, located at the Provincial Health Directorate, Saryab Link Road, Quetta.

Post	No of Posts	Eligibility Criteria
Female Staff Nurse (BPS-16)	60	Bachelor of Science (BSN) in Nursing from a University recognized by the Pakistan Nursing & Midwifery Council (PNMC), or a 3-year General Nursing Diploma along with a 1-year Midwifery course, or a 1-year Post Basic Specialization Diploma. Permanent PNMC Registration is required and mandatory. Verification of General Nursing and Midwifery / Specialization Diplomas from the issuing Board or PNMC. For BS Nursing degree holders, a certificate of completion for a 1-year internship training from a recognized hospital / institution must be submitted.

Terms and Conditions: Age limits will be in accordance with the Government of Balochistan's current policy. Female candidates from all over Pakistan are eligible to apply, though preference will be given to the local / domicile of Balochistan, subject to the satisfaction of the interview committee. Candidates shall not be regularized under any circumstances, however their contractual/adhoc tenure may be extended based on a satisfactory performance certificate issued by the Medical Superintendent of Sandeman Provincial Hospital, Quetta. Candidates will be entitled to receive pay in the respective basic scale, along with applicable allowances. Government, semi-government, and autonomous organization employees must apply through the proper channel with a NOC from their employer/parent department. Number of available positions can be increased or decreased at any point of time during the process. No TA/DA will be provided for attending the interview. Selection will be solely based on the recommendations of the Selection Committee thus any form of canvassing will lead to disqualification. Extra weightage will be given to candidates with specialization in Gynaecology, Medicine, Surgery, ICU, OT, and Rheumatology services. Candidates who have been terminated or dismissed from any government or non-government position due to disciplinary action, moral misconduct, or offenses are not eligible to apply. Concealment of facts or submission of forged documents will lead to immediate dismissal from the position, along with legal and disciplinary consequences. Selections will be at the sole discretion of the Divisional Health Committee, Quetta (Selection Committee), which also reserves the right to cancel the interview process at any time without providing any reasons.

How to apply: Interested and eligible female candidates should submit their applications to the Divisional Director Health Services, Quetta Division, along with two sets of attested copies of all relevant documents, including valid PNMC registration, educational certificates, professional experience, local/domicile certificate, CNIC, four passport-size photographs, and an updated CV. Please note that incomplete or late applications will not be considered. Applications must be submitted in person or via courier to the office of the Divisional Director Health Services, Quetta Division, located at the Provincial Health Directorate, Saryab Link Road, Quetta, by or before **27th December 2024**.
